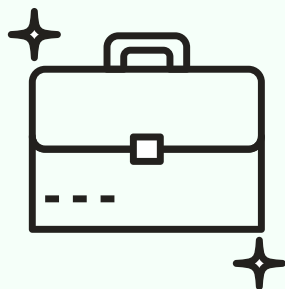

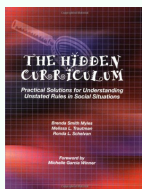
The Hidden Curriculum of Keeping a Job
