

EARN MORE USING WORK INCENTIVES

Work incentives are special rules that help you keep government benefits, like social security (SSI and SSDI), so you can work and earn money. With approved work incentives:



You can save money for things you need to work and be more independent.



You may be able to earn more money because you will have your paycheck and your benefits check.

You may be able to try working for a certain amount of time and not lose your benefits.



Money you make as a student may not count against your benefits.
